Purpose: To provide a scholarship to an athlete competing in the Arnold Track and Field Championships being held on March 3rd, 2012 and who is intending to pursue post-high school course of study at either college/university or other post-secondary educational institution.

NOTE: Payment of the scholarship by The Columbus Rotary Foundation, Inc. will only be made directly to a state approved institution of higher education in which the recipient is enrolled upon receipt by the Rotary Club of Columbus, Ohio, of a properly executed Scholarship Claim form.

This scholarship is further conditioned upon the recipient's continued demonstration of good moral character from the time of its award to its payment. The determination by the Rotary Club of Columbus, Ohio of whether or not the recipient has continued to demonstrate good moral character shall be final and binding on all parties and shall not be subject to review or appeal.

Award Components: One \$2,000 scholarship and individual certificate awarded to one student/athlete selected by the Arnold Sports Festival and Columbus Rotary Scholarship Committee.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be competing at the Arnold Track and Field Championships, March 3rd, 2012
2. Applicant must be a high school freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicant must demonstrate positive-impact involvement - in the complete sense - consistent with capacity and circumstances and/or significant improvement/success in scholarship and community involvement, documented through a letter of recommendation.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. One letter of recommendation from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
3. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the question on the enclosed essay form.
